Gagosian Gallery is pleased to announce an exhibition of new work by Chris Burden.

L.A.P.D. Uniform is an edition of 30 uniforms created in collaboration with the Fabric Workshop during Burden's 1992-1993 residency.

America's Darker Moments is a sculpture made of painted tin castings in the style of antique German toy figures, depicting the Kent State student uprising, the bombing of Hiroshima, the Kennedy assassination and the My Lai massacre.

Small Guns is a group of eight works dealing with weaponry in miniature, incorporating found and altered objects. The group includes works entitled "A Gentleman's Duel", "A Complete Small Army", "Men, Women and Children", "A Young American's Arsenal" and "Perfect, but Cruel".
