### Frank Gehry's "Fish Lamps" Opens at Gagosian Gallery in Beverly Hills and Paris

**Frank Gehry** is one of the most beloved and celebrated architects today, with enough collaborations and awards to affirm his legacy for decades to come. His most recently announced project is a series of *Fish Lamps* showing at both Gagosian Beverly Hills and Gagosian Paris.

The *Fish Lamps* series came from a 1983 commission by the Formica Corporation to create objects from their plastic laminate, ColorCore. He accidentally shattered a piece of it and discovered the result looked like fish scales. These photos are of the lamps as works-in-progress.
